5. Fundraising update

It has been a strange year, but fundraising has gone well. There has been lots of initiatives throughout the year:

- Summer tombola is currently ongoing. Great generous prizes and hampers being made on themes. Moira in school canteen making a hamper.
- To date we have sold £300.00 of Summer tombola tickets.

Recycling uniform

• This initiative has never been about raising money, it is just nice to meet parents and help with uniform. However, it raised £150.

Easy Fundraising

• We have raised £436 through this already and it is so easy to do as we shop online. Please download the app if you have not already as the school gets a % of each transaction.

Rag Bag Collections

Looking to see if this could be a possibility in school as a parent is interested in setting this
up. A permanent bin would be in the school grounds. This is to be discussed with Mr
McLaren.

HOP Project

- Whilst it is great we have raised money, we need to start using it. Plans are being looked at and although they take time, we are working hard to get the playground sorted.
- There will be a professional company coming in to do clean-up it to make sure it is done properly and effectively.
- Want to make sure we have central seating ideas Men Shed have been out to quote. Going
 to get a few more quotes too and go with the best option. We have also received quotes
 for the grassy playground.
- We are continuing to fundraise and look at getting money spent to make it an enjoyable playground to be in.
- There are 4 grants we have applied for that we have not heard back from yet: Asda, Tesco, CO-OP and CNOOC.
- Thanks to everyone who has donated. We cannot do this without you, and we really appreciate it.

6. School Report

Building Works - Progress is being made it is taking longer than hoped but we are finally seeing progress.

- **Front of school** some of the trees have gone. Now at stage where the barriers can be put in, hedge can get put up and the path can be created.
- The works should be finished by the time school returns in August.
- Toilets this has been delayed due to the backlog with building services due to COVID. Mr
 McLaren is working closely with the council to get this progressed in the holidays.

Other School Information:

- The projected school roll for next year is 1029
- Increase of teachers will require us to rethink organisation of classrooms and this is being looked at by building services too.
- There is ongoing work with building services to analyse our PE and catering needs in order to design a better solution for the school. What we have currently does not meet our needs but will require significant investment to improve.

Staffing

- Delighted to confirm Newly Qualified Teachers joining the team in Biology and Art.
- Unfortunately, we were unsuccessful with RME, English and Technical but are now in the process of recruiting for these posts.
- Also recruiting for a DHT the advert closes tomorrow (Friday 8th June)
- Due to increased uptake in Geography, we will need to consider recruiting a teacher in this area too.

 Ashleigh Wilson will be working from home from August due to the current COVID restrictions before maternity leave commences. PT replacement will be recruited. We will be allowed to recruit a permanent appointment.

Feedback from Parent Council

Mr McLaren requested feedback about the current break and lunch system at Harlaw. At
present the juniors and seniors are split which means 2 x break and lunch sessions. School
is looking to go back to same lunch however there would be 6 separate areas for bubbles
for the year groups to continue.

Feedback Given:

• It is a long afternoon for younger ones having such an early lunch so one lunch would be better.

SQA

- Good news we are planning to use provisional grades to all pupils tomorrow (Friday 18th
 June). Pupils will receive envelopes in school and those who have already left will get them
 in the post by Monday.
- Teachers have worked very hard to ensure pupils are given the best provisional grade. This will give pupils a chance to ask questions before the end of term and appeals procedure is there if needed. This will be for National 5, Higher and Advanced Higher results.

Parent Question – will pupils who did a subject at Grammar get results tomorrow?

A - Yes, they will. It will be in the envelope from Harlaw.

- Also, if course was undertaken at NESCOL they will contact students directly about provisional results over the next week.
- A huge amount of work has been undertaken by staff and Mr McLaren and the Parent Council pass on their thanks.

P7-S1 Transition

• Parent's Information Evening tonight for Transition. There has been an in-school experience this year and we are looking forward to welcoming them in August. Currently there are 180 on the S1 role but this may increase. Thank you to the school for the great transition.

School Timetabling

- Mrs Rennie has been working hard to put together the new timetable and it is great to say
 it is completed. The final checks are being done and the timetables will be issued during the
 first week of the holidays.
- We have been very ambitious this year to change the curriculum during COVID. It has been
 a huge amount of work, but we felt it was the right thing to do for our young people. Thank
 you to all parents for the patience. It has not been a typical year of timetable planning, but
 we want our young people to have the best.
- For the 2022/2023 session, we would prefer not to go with the Aug start, rather would propose the new timetable will run for 8 weeks before the summer holidays, from May, to give pupils maximum opportunity to start their new courses. This will be dependent on the situation with COVID-19 of course.

Parental Question – for those who normally receive an enhanced transition from year to year how will this happen this year if timetables are out during holidays?

A - For those who need it they will get a handwritten timetable next week. Please contact the school if you feel your child has been missed from the enhanced transition process.

Reporting

• Thanks to Laura and Angela for working so hard for the Parents Evening and Reporting. The process has been refined and school feel they are working well at it. The parent body have voiced that they would like to continue with online parent evenings.

- Mr McLaren commented that despite this challenging year for everyone we are making progress and achieving lots together. Grateful for support from Parent Council. We are at the start of journey, but we are moving in right direction.
- Great donation from Shell furniture and resources donation would have cost £30-40k if we were buying things in.
- Thanks to PC and members this is a great collaboration to drive school forward.

Parental Question: Is form / registration returning?

A - Yes, its returning in August. At 18 minutes, it is slightly longer due to COVID restrictions, but children will be in classroom for 12-13mins.
